† From Fr. David: We are at a time of the summer where we look more and more to the start of the academic year. The signpost for me is the Feast of the Assumption, the holy day of obligation which is this coming Tuesday, Aug 15. Please note that there is a morning Mass and an evening Mass on that day. Let us approach that feast with gratitude for some of the blessings of the summer, which might include family reunions, travels, sight seeing, outdoor activities, and so on. Let us always include the blessings of forgiveness and life in Christ. In particular, the Assumption of Mary, body and soul into heaven, leads us to reflect on our destiny with the Holy Trinity, with Mary and the saints, and with countless angels in heaven. ► Alpha is coming! This course was well received when we ran it the first time last spring, and I hope many others will have the opportunity to participate in it when it starts at SFX on Sept 11 (we will run it at SMM in February).
