† **From Fr. David:** We continue to celebrate our joy in the risen Lord in the Easter season. Our first readings all through the season, from the book of Acts, describe the very first Catholic community, which was in Jerusalem, as they lived in the grace of the risen Jesus. My homilies will often connect with the readings from Acts, so I invite you to read those readings closely. ► Today we will have nominations for parish council and finance council at the end of Mass. ► The parishes of Jefferson County are seeking several couples who are willing to be trained to teach Natural Family Planning to the people of our county. **Pope Francis, *Evangelii Gaudium* #127-128.** There is a kind of preaching which falls to each of us as a daily responsibility. It has to do with bringing the Gospel to the people we meet, whether they be our neighbors or complete strangers...Being a disciple means being constantly ready to bring the love of Jesus to others...The first step is personal dialogue, when the other person speaks and shares his or her joys, hopes and concerns for loved ones, or so many other heartfelt needs. Only afterwards is it possible to bring up God's word, perhaps by reading a Bible verse or relating a story, but always keeping in mind the fundamental message: the personal love of God who became man, who gave himself up for us, who is living and who offers us his salvation and his friendship...If the circumstances are right, this fraternal and missionary encounter could end with a brief prayer related to the concerns which the person may have expressed.
