†  **From Fr. David** Alpha and Beta are coming! Alpha will start Sept 13 and go ten Thursdays, all at SFX. Beta will start Sept 24 and go six Mondays at SMM. Please remember that Alpha is a program to help people enter and grow in a relationship with Jesus (it's not a Bible study, and it's not a catechism—it's all about relating to God through Jesus). Alpha is the same presentation every season, the same videos every time we do it, but Beta changes every time. Beta is meant to be a follow-up to Alpha, although it is open to anyone. This fall, Beta will be on the letter to the Philippians, one of Paul's letters in the New Testament. Please start thinking about participating in Alpha or Beta this fall. More is coming. ► The new columbarium was installed this past week at St. Mary Magdalene Cemetery in Johnson Creek. Thanks to Dale Schmeling, Spike Klockow, and our parishioners who helped install it! Seeing it in person, I was surprised at how tall and massive it is! It is six-and-a-half feet tall, and it is in the area by the crucifix. Take a look at it sometime. A columbarium is an above-ground repository for the ashes of cremated people. There are 5 niches arranged vertically on each side of the column for a total of 20 niches. A person can print name of the deceased and other information on the door of the niche. Thanks to the Daughters of Mary for donating \$5,000 for our purchase. ► This weekend I will offer a blessing to all who are celebrating a wedding anniversary in the month of August. After Communion I will ask them to stand for a blessing. Congratulations!
