**† From Fr. David:** May the recollections of Jesus and his rising from the dead bring you joy in these days! The eight days from Easter Sunday until today are called the "Octave of Easter," very joyful celebrations where I use Eucharistic Prayer #1 and the Alleluia Dismissal at the end of Mass. Both today and next Sunday we will have Gospel accounts of Jesus' post-resurrection appearances. In the 40 days between Jesus' resurrection and ascension, he appeared to his disciples and spoke with them about the kingdom of God and the scriptures that pertained to him. The 50-day Easter season goes from Easter Sunday until Pentecost. On Sundays of Easter season we will use the Apostles' Creed instead of the Nicene Creed. The Apostles' Creed more closely resembles the affirmations we make when we renew our baptismal promises. ► Our annual Confirmation retreat went well! All of our students participated well, and we had four university students from St. Paul's in Madison lead it. I am grateful to Mary Paulowske and her helpers for the much-appreciated dinner! Please pray for our 15 high school juniors who will be Confirmed next Sunday afternoon at St. Bernard's-Watertown. ► I invite anyone who would like to intercede for our parish to gather on Tuesday, April 24 at 6:30 at SFX. I hope we can do this regularly and alternate locations between our two churches.
