† **From Fr. David:** Several members of our parish are interested in obtaining a columbarium (a memorial monument that stores cremated remains of our faithful departed) for St. Mary Magdalene Cemetery. A growing number of cemeteries now have columbaria. We have done some research and would like to present it Wednesday, January 31 at 9 am at SMM, after the morning Mass. All are invited. ►Our Alpha and Beta courses begin in one week. Please consider registering (call the contact persons printed later in this bulletin). Alpha is an introduction to discipleship, while Beta goes more in depth into the life of discipleship. **Ask the Pastor** Q. How can I find an Alpha course where my daughter lives, in another state? A. The Alpha website, [alphausa.org](http://alphausa.org), has a "Find and Alpha" feature. Enter the name of the city. I suggest that your daughter attend the Alpha course in a Catholic church. For example, I found that currently Madison has 6 registered Alpha courses scheduled for this spring, Milwaukee has 13, and the corridor between Madison and Milwaukee has one (ours). In total, 13 of these 18 courses (72%) are offered in a Catholic church. Alpha is also offered in prisons, restaurants, and workplaces, but as far as I can tell, this spring all the offerings in our area will be in churches. ►Jeff Cavins, author and teacher, member of Catholic Alpha Advisory Board: "If anyone wants to follow Christ and enter into His mission, they must clearly understand what they are embarking on. Alpha sets the course and clearly spells out what is required to follow the Son of God. There is no greater adventure in life."
