FAITH IN CHRIST JESUS

When we first listen to the words of Jesus today, they might strike us as being unfair. Is Jesus really being mean to the Canaanite woman because she is not Jewish? Perhaps Jesus knew that this woman be persistent in her request and it gave him a teachable moment to show that the Kingdom of God is, indeed, for all people.

In the first reading, prophet Isaiah tells us that all people are included in God's plan of salvation. In Paul's letter, he teaches that salvation through Jesus is available to both Jews and Gentiles, for the Father is merciful to all who believe. In the Gospel, Jesus grants a healing miracle to the daughter of a Canaanite woman, a Gentile.
