We are called each day to fill our spiritual lamps with the oil of prayer and good works. At baptism, we were admonished to keep the light of Christ burning brightly. The oil in such lamps cannot be borrowed from someone else, but must be of our own volition. When God calls us to eternity, what will count is how ready we are to meet him face-to face.

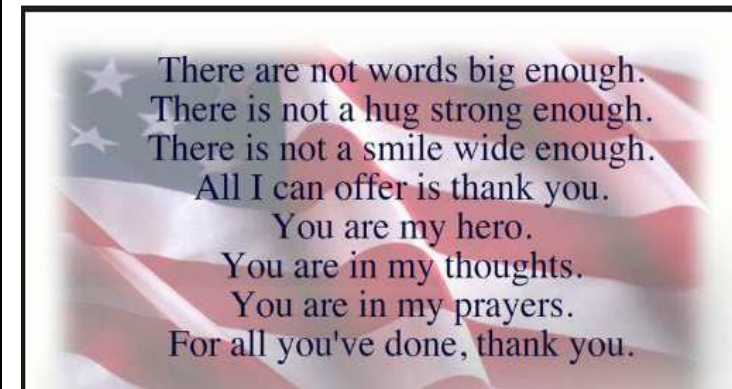
Today's first reading tells us that wisdom awaits us if we sincerely seek her. The psalm also has a tone of yearning and longing for God's help. The Gospel reminds us of what we must do in order to be ready when the Lord calls. He will come suddenly, unexpectedly, and we will recognize him only if we are prepared.
