JESUS TEACHES US HOW TO RECONCILE OUR EARTHLY COMMITMENTS WITH OUR OBLIGATIONS TO GOD

Jesus challenges us to examine how we demonstrate our fidelity to him while living in the world. Do worldly attachments or loyalties get in the way of being faithful to Jesus and his teachings? Today's readings show that there need not be a conflict between fulfilling our civil government obligations and our obligations to God. In today's first reading, as we heard Isaiah declaring that the God of Israel is the one and only God. In the second reading, Paul gives thanks for those who have listened to him and follow Jesus. In the Gospel, Jesus showed that there does not have to be a conflict between loyalty to God and observance of obligations.
