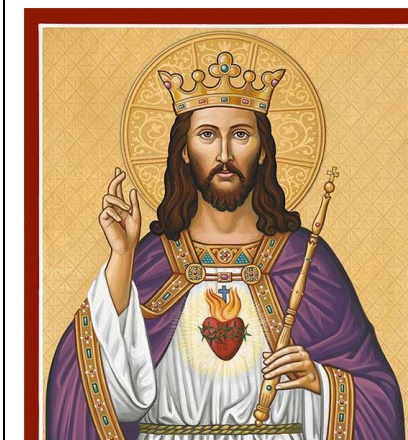
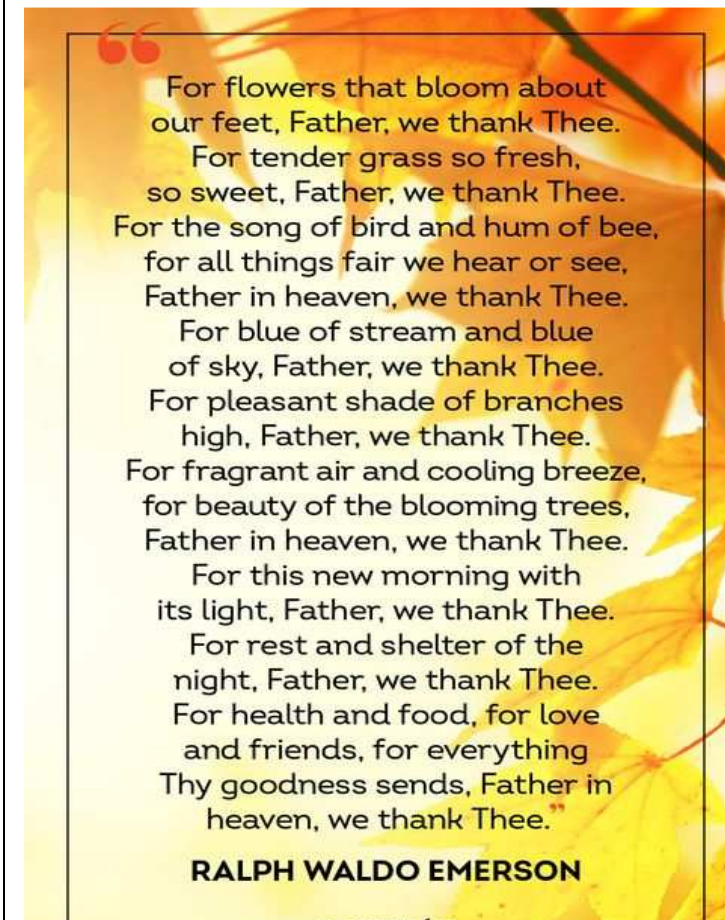
**DISTRIBUTION OF MISSALETTES**
